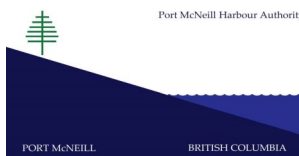

Harbour and Visitor Centre Parking Passes

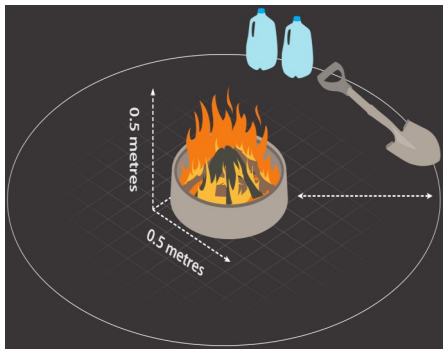
Annual parking and boat launch passes are now available for purchase and pick up at the Harbour Office for the 2021 season.
