Property Tax Notices

Property tax notices were mailed late May.

If you did not receive yours, please contact the Town Office.

The due date for payment of property taxes is July 2, 2021. Keep in mind that the Town Office is closed Thursday, July 01, 2021 for Canada Day.

You may pay property taxes by cash, cheque and credit card or if you bank with CIBC or CCCU you can pay your property taxes online in the bill payments section using the roll number on your tax notice as your account number.

Residents no longer apply for the home owner grant through the municipal office. Everyone must now apply directly to the province using a new online or telephone system.

2021 Home Owner Grants

You will need your social insurance number and tax notice in order to claim the home owner grant. Look for instructions on your property tax notice. For more information visit www.gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant or call 1-888-355-2700. Please remember that you must apply each year for the Home Owner **IMPORTANT NOTE ** Grant (if you are eligible).




The roll number to use when applying for the home owner grant online is at the bottom of your tax notice and usually starts with 2 zeros, the system will add a decimal point.

Backyard fires no larger than 0.5m x 0.5m in a fire ring are permitted. If you would like to dispose of yard waste, our Public Works department provides a bin for this debris. The bin is located next to the Town's Public Works Yard at 681 Tower Street. Thank you for your cooperation.
