

2021 Home Owner Grants

There have been changes to the Home Owner Grant process.

Residents no longer apply for the home owner grant through the municipal office. Everyone must now apply directly to the province using a new online or telephone system.

Wait to apply for the home owner grant until you receive your property tax notice. You will need your social insurance number and tax notice in order to claim the home owner grant. Look for instructions on your property tax notice.

Please remember that you must apply each year for the Home Owner Grant (if you are eligible).

Property Tax Notices

Property tax notices are typically mailed mid to late May. If you do not receive yours by mid June, please contact the Town Office as some title changes do not have PO Box #'s included.

The due date for payment of property taxes is July 2, 2021. Keep in mind that the Town Office is closed Thursday, July 01, 2021 for Canada Day.

You may pay property taxes by cash, cheque and credit card or if you bank with CIBC or CCCU you can pay your property taxes online in the bill payments section using your roll number on your tax notice as your account number.

2021 Census

Public Reminder - Keep Pets Leashed In Town

The Town of Port McNeill office would like to remind pet owners to keep their pets leashed when travelling through town. Pets are welcomed to be off leash in the dog park located off Broughton boulevard, behind the Centennial Baseball Park.



Reminder from the Harbour Manager

As of May 1st, parking in lots A & B will be restricted to day use only, no overnights. Failure to comply will result in parking tickets, or removal from the lot by a local towing company.

Parking can be paid for in the office during office hours, or at one of the 2 parking meters located on Broughton Boulevard. Additionally, annual passes can be acquired from the Harbour Office.



WildSafeBC Tips for Avoiding Bear Encounters

- •Watch for bears signs like tracks, scat or over turned debris.
- •Talk or sing to avoid surprising a bear. Bear bells are not recommended as they are not recognized as human.
 - •Be aware of your surroundings and do not use headphones in bear country.
- •Manage your attractants and never put someone else at risk by leaving organics behind. Pack out what you pack in.
- •Travel with another person, which will result in more noise and may help dissuade a bear from approaching.



•Carry bear spray and be able to access it quickly. Do not carry it in your pack or attached to your bike.

If heading to a provincial or federal park, check their websites for wildlife alerts or safety considerations. When travelling, check in with visitor centres to find out about local wildlife activity.
