


We will be notifying you in the weeks ahead when the Draft Plan and Zoning Bylaw are ready for public review. This is the part of the process where residents will give their input and let us know

**\*Please note: This will be a whole town parade and may take several hours to complete**




**The theme this year is that there is no theme! Feel free to dress up, decorate those floats, or vehicles anyway you feel fit! We would love to see your creativity.**
