For information regarding garbage and recycling pick-up please call Fox's Disposal at 250-949-6306

•Watch for bears signs like tracks, scat or over turned debris.

•Talk or sing to avoid surprising a bear. Bear bells are not recommended as they are not recognized as human.

•Be aware of your surroundings and do not use headphones in bear country.

•Manage your attractants and never put someone else at risk by leaving organics behind. Pack out what you pack in.

•Travel with another person, which will result in more noise and may help dissuade a bear from approaching.

•Carry bear spray and be able to access it quickly. Do not carry it in your pack or attached to your bike.



If heading to a provincial or federal park, check their websites for wildlife alerts or safety considerations. When travelling, check in with visitor centres to find out about local wildlife activity.



2022 Property Tax Notices

Property tax notices are typically mailed mid to late May. If you do not receive yours by early June, please contact the Town Office as some title changes do not have PO Box #'s.

The due date for payment of property taxes is July 4, 2022. Keep in mind that the Town Office is closed Friday, July 01, 2022 for Canada Day. You may pay property taxes by cash, cheque, debit or online banking in the bill payments section using roll number on your tax notice as your account number.

2022 Home Owner Grant

Homeowners now apply directly to the province using the online or telephone system.

Wait to apply for the home owner grant until you receive your property tax notice.

Make sure to apply for your Home Owner Grant prior to the property tax payment deadline of July 4, 2022.

You will need your social insurance number and tax notice in order to claim a home owner grant.

Look for instructions on your property tax notice or call the Town Office for help.
