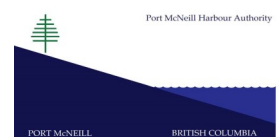

2022 Property Taxes

Property tax notices were mailed late May. If you have not received yours, please contact the Town Office. You may pay property taxes by cash, cheque, debit or online banking in the bill payments section.

Credit cards are no longer accepted.

Home Owner Grant

Homeowners now apply directly to the province using the online or telephone system. Make sure to apply for your Home Owner Grant prior to the property tax payment deadline of July 4, 2022.

You will need your social insurance number and 2022 property tax notice in order to claim a home owner grant.
