
Director – Emergency Support Services (ESSD) Volunteer Position

The Town of Port McNeill is seeking a motivated individual for the volunteer position of Emergency Support Services Director (ESSD). Emergency Support Services (ESS) is a provincial program that provides services to those individuals who are displaced from their homes due to an emergency. The program provides 72 hours of services such as shelter, food and clothing. The Emergency Support Services Director (ESSD) is responsible for the planning, development, implementation, and management of an ESS program and the recruitment of volunteers to enable the community to respond quickly and effectively in providing essential services to evacuees and responders affected by an emergency or disaster. The ESSD reports to the Emergency Program Coordinator (EPC) and works with Emergency Management BC (EMBC) as well as Public Works employees. Completion of basic training through online and in person courses and a criminal record check are requirements of the role.

As a reminder, garbage receptacles must have a secure cover or lid and must not exceed seventy (70) liters or more than 25 kg. (55 lbs.)








