BC Hydro will be replacing Port McNeill's streetlights with energy-efficient LEDs to ensure compliance with new federal regulations that require all light ballasts containing Poly-Chlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) be removed .



These new streetlights will help improve public safety in our community by increasing the visibility of sidewalks and roads at night, as well as help reduce light pollution. LEDs also last longer and require less maintenance. This work should begin on December 5, 2022
