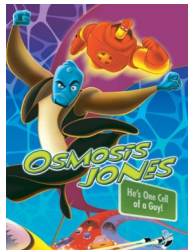

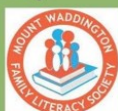
Gardners, growers & foragers welcome to the annual springtime seed exchange. Bring seeds you would like to share or choose something new to grow.

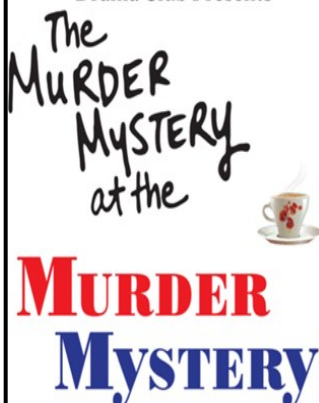

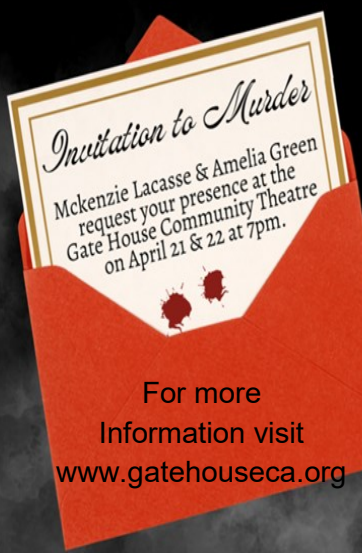
