Position Summary:

An Employee in this position performs highly skilled lifeguarding, instructional and supervisory work of a complex nature. Work involves the moderate supervision of lifeguards, and overall pool activities. Ensuring that our pool provides professional lifeguard services to patrons, including but not limited to; educating about pool safety, preventing unsafe activities and behaviours, intervening, and providing rescue assistance for patrons having difficulty or in distress, and administering first aid as required.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Administration:
 - Complete daily attendance and maintenance logs
 - Communicate special needs, problems, ideas, and positive occurrences to Manager of Visitor Experience
 - Request supplies/maintenance, assist with arranging schedules and ensuring coverage for staffing levels are achieved daily
- 2. Delivery of Aquatic Centre programs:
 - Prepare and present activities for special events
 - Assist with the development of promotional materials for the Aquatic Centre
 - Ensure all swimmers are in appropriate areas
 - Provide a high standard of customer service to patrons and public
- 3. Safety and Comfort of Patrons
 - Recognize and prevent hazardous situations, enforce, and explain pool rules as required
 - Perform additional cleaning of change rooms, pool deck, office, and pool lobby as required
 - Execute emergency and Standard First Aid procedures as required, complete forms for ambulance personnel and Aquatic Centre
 - Maintain constant contact with public to be readily available to respond to questions or concerns
